



MIPI[®] Alliance Policy on Source code Disclosures by MIPI Members of Software Implementing a MIPI Specification

Approved 26 January 2009 by the MIPI Alliance Board of Directors

This document sets forth the MIPI policy on disclosures of source code (and related explanations) of software implementing any part of a Board adopted MIPI Specification. Pursuant to the Board's authority under the MIPI Bylaws, including but not limited to Article 10, Section 4, the Board has concluded that MIPI Members may disclose the source code of software that implements any portion(s) of a MIPI specification (including comments that explain how the software works) to any third party without any confidentiality obligation and any such disclosure is not a breach of any confidentiality obligation under the MIPI Member Agreement or MIPI Bylaws. The source code may also include explanatory references to MIPI specifications (e.g., “/* tx_foo needs to stay high until the DMA is complete [MIPI HSI 1.4.5] */”) but may not include any portions of the specifications themselves, except as authorized by MIPI's Policy on Disclosure by MIPI Members of Board-adopted MIPI Specifications which may be viewed at http://www.mipi.org/MIPI-Policy-Adopted-Specifications-Disclosures_PUBLIC.pdf.

This Policy is intended to clarify that the MIPI Member Agreement should not be interpreted to prevent MIPI Members from distributing software under licenses that require that source code be made available to licensees, such as the GNU General Public License (GPL) and the Eclipse Public License (EPL).
